



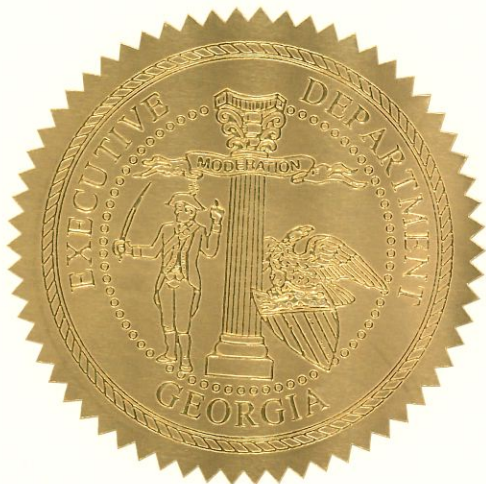

A PROCLAMATION

COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING
AWARENESS MONTH

- WHEREAS:** Colorectal cancer is the second-leading cause of cancer deaths in the United States among men and women combined. Every 3 minutes, someone is diagnosed with colorectal cancer, and every 10 minutes someone dies from colorectal cancer; and
- WHEREAS:** Colorectal cancer is one of the few cancers that can be prevented with timely screening, and 39 percent of colorectal cancer patients have their cancers detected at an early stage, but 1 in 3 eligible Americans are not up to date on screening; and
- WHEREAS:** Gastroenterologists perform colonoscopies to prevent or detect CRC by removing colon polyps, and the survival rate of individuals who have early-stage colorectal cancer is 90 percent but is only 10 percent when diagnosed after it has spread to other organs; and
- WHEREAS:** In 2024 there were approximately 152,810 new cases and 53,010 deaths from colorectal cancer; and
- WHEREAS:** The national goal established by the National Colorectal Cancer Roundtable is to strive to increase timely colorectal cancer screening rates to 80 percent in every community for all Americans eligible for screening; and
- WHEREAS:** Organizations and institutions in Georgia such as GDC Endoscopy Center, Gwinnett Digestive Clinic, American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ASGE), Emory Winship Cancer Institute, and others are committed to providing support and education to colorectal cancer patients and as well as their families and care givers, as greater awareness and further research efforts may lead to a cure one day; and
- WHEREAS:** Observing a Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month during the month of March provides a special opportunity to increase awareness and offer education on the importance of early detection and screening of colorectal cancer; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 2025, as COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 12th day of February in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.
